The long-eared owl can be confused with other owl species The great-horned owl (*Bubo virginianus*), which is similarly patterned and also has prominent ear tufts, can be distinguished from the long-eared owl by its larger size and stockier body The eastern screech owl (*Otus asio*) is much smaller than the long-eared owl and differs in coloration,

The long-eared owl averages 13 to 16 inches in length and is about the same size as the American crow It is a slim owl with long ear tufts that are fairly close together on the head The brown feathers are lighter on the belly with lengthwise streaks BEHAVIORS The long-eared owl is an uncommon migrant and winter resident in Illinois

Long-eared Owl Asio otus Habitat Preference: The Long-eared Owl is considered an edge species because it alternates its time between dense woodland patches and adjacent grassland and prairie marshes It typically nests and roosts in thick stands of conifer trees Ideally the trees are rank and the limbs reach the ground
